Past recipients of this scholarship are not eligible.

Essay: Attach a one-page, typed double-spaced essay that explains in your own words what you believe is an architect's role in society and/or what you would like to accomplish as an architect.

Work sample: Attach photographs or copies of up to five examples of art, CADD work, graphics, or architecture projects. Samples must be presented on no more than five 8-1/2" x 11" pages. (Please do not send originals; samples will not be returned.)

Biography: Include an outline of accomplishments and experiences relevant to your application (*e.g.*, awards, courses completed, work experience, travel, volunteer activities).

References: Include up to three letters of reference. Letters should support the applicant's understanding of architecture, commitment to the profession and maturity. At least one letter must be from a current teacher.
